They had a son named Samuel Weeks b: 1804 d: 1862 and he had a brother James M. Weeks B: 1801. NOTE, my 12 marker YDNA matches a William Weeks 11/12 on Weeks surname group. 5/25/11: could not find a Daniel Weekes in 1840 Maryland census. I did find a Daniel Weekes in the Ohio 1840 census. This census showed 1M 5-9, 1M 10-14, 1 M 15-19, 1 M 20-29, 1 M 50-59, 4 FM's, 2 farm employees. They all lived in Bristol, Morgan OH. SCW moved to Ohio in the 1830's.

On the message board someone responded with, " I knew about the Ohio connection in Marion Co. from some family photos in an album. My grandmother said those were the Weeks relatives in Ohio, and she thought -- not sure -- the woman was named Jane Weeks wife of Samuel C. Weeks. She was sure that there was an Ohio Jane Weeks somewhere in the family, though. There was another photo of some girls. On the back of the photo was a Marion, OH location."</p> <p>The person that sent me this information, from Ancestry message board. He also gave me information regarding 2 second cousins living in Texas. The Hezekiah is the closet I've come to a solid lead but I can't confirm it. I couldn't find a son of Hezekiah Weeks with a son named Samuel. Note: there was a Hezekiah who had a son Samuel (from Wayne Weeks Tree) but he was born in MA. See ref: 11-1.4 1/17/11 one of their sons was Hezekiah B: 1815, wife Rachel Henry. Their son Hezekiah B: 1842, married in 1867 in Howard Co. As fast as this information became available it went away. The person who provided the information used his screen name and he hasn't responded to any of my messages over the past year and on ancestry.com his profile page shows he has been inactive for over 6 months. 5/27/11 Another Hezekiah Weeks b: 1764 who's parents were Hezekiah Weeks 1739 – 1819 and Ruth Cole 1744 – 1830. is Cole the C. in Samuel C.
